Accommodations at Daybreak

Tenting - Tent sights located on the main lawn, up in the redwood canyon or under the stars.

Space is unlimited

RV's - 12 sites in the lower parking lot, shaded and high above the San Lorenzo river, with water and electricity hook ups. No dump service available.

Space is limited.

Cabins - 9 rustic (16 bed) cabins located in the redwood canyon. Families may reserve an entire cabin for their family or share with other families.

Spaces are limited.

Live Oak - 3 private rooms. Share restroom.

Creekside Cabin - 4 semi private rooms, dorm-style. Share restroom.

Tent cabin - (12 beds) dorm style. Walk to restroom.

Barn - (8 beds) dorm style. Walk to restroom.

All accommodations (except tenting) are on a first reserve basis.
